CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter presents the conclusions and suggestions. The conclusions are the answers of formulated problem in chapter one and the suggestion contains the writer's suggestions for students, readers and other researchers related to this study.

5.1 Conclusions

The search for personal identity is an important problems that appears in every age level human life. Every people need to understand and learn about how to communicate their personal identity confussion. Literature is one way to understand about this problem. By reading a literary works like mockingbird novel, the reader can get a story that provides a real problem in human psychological perspective including the identity confusion and the finding. That is why the writer brings the novel into a research and comes to the following conclusion.

Caitlin Smith, a young girl who is also the main character in this novel, has brought some interesting problems which had been reasearched and bring out some conclusions. Caitlin is characterized as a girl who has good personalities but suffer from Asperger Syndrome. She is smart, honest and polite girl . Caitlin can understand easily about the various language used. She also has a strong skill to identify the meaning of one word, Caitlin is also an honest girl because she often said her opinion directly no matter it will make people become more irritated to her. 5.2 Suggestions

The researcher would like to give some suggestions related to this study. The suggestions are aimed to the English Department, readers and other researcher.

1. To English Students

For the English students of Mercubuana University or other universities, the study can be used as a help in understanding a literary work, especially fo the novel Mockingbird . By reading this study, the students of English will gets an ideas about the novel . The study also can be used as a starter for a deeper analysis on the same novel or comparison for different novel.

2. To Reader

The readers that read this study will get more knowledge and enjoyment in reading their Mockingbird novel. Not only it gives deeper insight about the search of personal identity problems but the reader also can get a better perspective about the unique of every children and the role of psychological perspective in educational world.

3. To Other Researcher

This study focuses on the search of personal identity problems from the main chracter of the novel, other researcher could use the study as a starting point to conduct other research of the novel, such as the moral value, the sociological approach and also the grammatical problems that appears from the used of uncommon adjective capitalisation in the novel. Other approaches like formalist approach and biographical aprroach from the novel writer can also be an interesting object to observ

4. To English Teacher.
