

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif *inidfferent* orangtua dengan perilaku asertif pada remaja korban *bullying*. Penelitian ini diharapkan dapat bermanfaat sebagai sumber informasi dan referensi baru mengenai hubungan antara persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif *indifferent* orangtua dengan perilaku asertif pada remaja korban *bullying*. Penelitian ini dilakukan di salah satu sekolah menengah atas di Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta (DIY) dengan sarakteristik subjek penelitian adalah remaja yang mengenyam pendidikan sekolah menengah atas (SMA) yang tinggal dengan kedua orangtua. Pengumpulan data penelitian menggunakan skala bullying, skala perilaku asertif dan skala pola asuh permisif *indifferent* orangtua. Penulisan aitem skala *bullying* mengacu pada bentuk-bentuk *bullying* yang dikemukakan oleh Beane (2008), skala perilaku asertif mengacu pada aspek-aspek perilaku asertif menurut Alberti & Emmons (2002) dan skala pola asuh permisif *indfferent* orangtua yang mengacu pada aspek-aspek pola asuh permisif *indifferent* orangtua dikemukakan oleh Widyarini (2009). Berdasarkan analisis data yang dilakukan, terdapat hubungan antara persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif *indfferent* orangtua dengan perilaku asertif pada remaja korban *bullying*. Koefisien korelasi antara persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif inidfferent orangtua dengan perilaku asertif pada remaja korban bullying sebesar $r_{xy} = -0,254$ dan taraf signifikan $p=0,014$ ($p<0,050$) menunjukan adanya hubungan negatif antara persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif *indifferent* orangtua dengan perilaku asertif yang signifikan, artinya hipotesis diterima. Hal ini menjelaskan bahwa semakin positif persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif *indifferent* orangtua maka cenderung semakin rendah perilaku asertif. Sebaliknya semakin negatif persepsi anak terhadap pola asuh permisif *indifferent* orangtua maka cenderung semakin tinggi perilaku asertif.

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the relationship between children's perceptions of parenting permissive patterns in different parents with an assertive behavior in teensvictims bullying. This study is expected to be useful as a source of new information and references about the relationship between children's perceptions of parenting and different with an assertive behavior in teensvictims bullying. This research was conducted in one high school in Yogyakarta with research subject characteristic is adolescents who have high school education who live with both parents. Research data collection using a scale of bullying, assertive behavior scale and the scale of permissive parenting in different parents. The writing of scales bullying refers to forms of bullying proposed by Beane (2008), the scale of an assertive behavior refers to aspects of an assertive behavior according to Alberti & Emmons (2002) and scale indifferent parenting parenting that refers to aspects of parenting permissive in different parents expressed by Widyarini (2009). Based on data analysis performed, there is correlation between perception of child to parenting in different parenting with assertive behavior on adolescent victim bullying. The correlation coefficient between the perception of the child to the parental permissive parenting pattern with the assertive attitudes in the bullying teenager of bullying is $r_{xy} = -0,254$ and the significant level $p = 0,014$ ($p < 0,050$) shows a negative relation between the child's perception to parenting pattern in different with behavior assertive significance, meaning the hypothesis is accepted. This explains that positive the child's perception of parenting parenting pattern in different, the lower the assertive behavior. Conversely, negative the perception of the child to parenting parenting pattern is in different more likely to be higher assertive behavior.
