CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is divided into two sections which are conclusions and suggestions. The conclusions are written based on the formulated research questions. It comprises the final conclusion of each objective in this research. Besides, in the second section, the writer will provide suggestion to parties that will be affected by this research.

5.1 Conclusion

From the research it can be concluded that there are six events of speeches that occur in the movie "The King's Speech". From each event, a total of 27 datum was determined. From these data, there were 5 types of language style that was used in the movie based on Martin Joos Theory. They are frozen style, formal style, consultative style, casual style and intimate style. Frozen style appeared the most in this research as the speeches were performed by heads of government which explains the degree and need of formality.

It can be also concluded that there are 5 effects of language style that appeared in the movie. They are "To Persuade The Reader", "To Increase the Audience's Taste", "To Add the Artistic Effect of the Idea Being Offered by the Writer", "To Create a Certain Mood", "To Make the Writer's Idea Clearer". To create a certain mood appeared the most as it is an obligation of the speaker to set the mood of the address so that the people can understand the message.

The Function of Speech is also researched in this paper. The researcher found six functions of speech in this research. They are expressive, directive, referential, metalinguistic, poetic and phatic. The most that appeared are referential which shows that the speaker spoken based on data and phatic, which means that the speaker shows compassion and empathy to their people.

5.2 Suggestion

In this section, the researcher will provide some recommendations in regard to the research for some related parties as follows:

For the readers of this research, it is recommended to have a basic understanding of the concept of language style and speech as an act. Sociolinguistic is the base study for this research. To have previously engaged in a sociolinguistic learning will provide a more comprehensive learning of this research. Since this research is based on a movie, the researcher recommend to watch the movie first to understand the context of the movie..

For the other researchers, a further study related to the language style and speech function in "The King's Speech" movie is recommended. In general, the limitation of this research is that it focuses on the language style aspect of the speech and no other subjects of sociolinguistic. It is also needed to further research the sociolinguistic effect on learning and speech making process. In addition, the next researcher can use this theory to analyze another topic by finding the type and the reason at the same time.
