

## **ABSTRAK**

Masa remaja adalah periode penting dalam pengambilan keputusan karier, seringkali dihadapkan pada tantangan. Pola asuh permisif dari orang tua yang kurang memberikan arahan dapat memperburuk kesulitan ini. Hipotesis penelitian ini menyatakan adanya hubungan negatif antara pola asuh permisif dan pengambilan keputusan karier pada remaja madya. Subjek penelitian adalah 144 remaja berusia 14-18 tahun. Data dikumpulkan menggunakan Skala Pola Asuh Permisif dan Skala Pengambilan Keputusan Karier. Penelitian kuantitatif ini menggunakan analisis *product moment*. Berdasarkan hasil analisis diperoleh koefisien korelasi sebesar ( $r = -0.391$ ). Hasil tersebut menunjukkan bahwa ada hubungan negatif yang signifikan antara pola asuh permisif dengan pengambilan keputusan karier pada remaja madya. Hipotesis diterima dengan koefisien determinasi (*R-square*) sebesar 0.153, berarti pola asuh permisif berkontribusi sebesar 15.3% terhadap pengambilan keputusan karier, sementara 84.7% dipengaruhi faktor lain.

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*Adolescence is an important period of career decision-making, often faced with challenges. Permissive parenting from parents who lack direction can exacerbate these difficulties. This study hypothesized a negative relationship between permissive parenting and career decision-making in middle adolescents. The subjects of the study were 144 adolescents aged 14-18 years. Data were collected using the Permissive Parenting Scale and the Career Decision Making Scale. This quantitative research uses product moment analysis. Based on the results of the analysis, the correlation coefficient was obtained ( $r = -0.391$ ). These results indicate that there is a significant negative relationship between permissive parenting and career decision making in middle adolescents. The hypothesis is accepted with a coefficient of determination ( $R$ -square) of 0.153, meaning that permissive parenting contributes 15.3% to career decision making, while 84.7% is influenced by other.*
